# 1. ASTD to date

- Need for reliable Arctic shipping data
- Three years work
  - ASTD Expert Group
  - PAME Secretariat
- Using Havbase as a platform
- ASTD development in 2018
- ASTD launch October 2018

## 2. Aim of the workshop

- To overview and test the ASTD System
- To teach the participants to use the system
- To look for any problems/errors

# 3. Expectations

- Participants need to learn how to use the system **AND** be able to teach other future users from your country on it
  - You will be points of contact of future users
  - Answer questions and help to use the system
- PAME Secretariat and the Norwegian Coastal Administration will be of assistance
- User guide to be developed

# 4. ASTD Access and user rights

- *ASTD Cooperative Agreements* amongst the 8 Arctic Council member states steers access
- Four levels of access:
  - **Level 1:** Arctic States that are current on their annual pro rata share financial contributions.
  - **Level 2:** Arctic States that are current on their annual pro rata share financial contributions.
  - **Level 3:** Arctic States that are not current on their full annual pro rata share financial contributions; Permanent Participants; Arctic Council Subsidiary Bodies; Arctic Council Observers that have made a financial contribution of an amount decided by PAME member governments to the administration, maintenance and operation of the Network.
  - **Level 4:** General public, open viewing online.

# 4. ASTD Access and user rights

- Level 1 data: Download all data with IMO and MMSI number (names of ships)
  - Possible but with a specific request
  - PAME Secretariat will download and send the data
- Level 2 data: General access for governments

# Level 3 access

*“A Participant may request LEVEL 3 access on behalf of an **accredited academic institution** or **other recognized research entity** under the terms and conditions described in the ASTD Framework and this section, the signing of a data sharing arrangement (Attachment Two), and the payment of a financial contribution by the academic institution or research entity in an amount to be decided by PAME.”*



# Level 3 – Fee structure

- E.g:
  - Arctic Council Observers
  - Accredited academic institutions
  - Recognized research entities
- PAME Secretariat administers users

Nr.	Time	Cost (USD)
1.	1 month	500
2.	3 months	800
3.	6 months	1000
4.	12 months	1500
5.	36 months	4000
6.	48 months	5000

# 4. How to get access?

- You are points of contact for your country
  - E.g. university wants data, you will help
  - PAME Secretariat of assistance
- User forms to apply for access to be created
  - Sent to PAME Secretariat who administers access
  - You are the bridge between
  - Available online – takes a few days
  - No access until payment (if applicable)
