Agenda item 6 - Framework for a pan-Arctic Marine Protected Areas (MPA) Network

<u>Project title:</u> An inventory of area-based conservation measures for achieving effective long-term conservation of Arctic biodiversity in networks of marine protected areas.

Agenda item 7 - Ecosystem-based Approach to Management (Norway and USA)

Project Proposal for EPPR and PAME 2015-2017 work plans.

<u>Project title:</u> Linking Ecosystem-Based Management and Arctic Offshore Oil and Gas decisionmaking

WWF is proposing a joint EPPR/PAME project to identify national approaches to the use of the Ecosystem Approach in offshore oil and gas decision-making related to oil spill prevention, preparedness, and response. Please see attached project proposal.

WWF already submitted the proposal to EPPR in December and are submitting this for possible inclusion in both PAME and EPPR 2015-2017 work plans.

This proposal was distributed to the EA expert group on 8th of January.
