- Canada, Norway and the US co-leading
- Numerous versions informed by workshops and wide distribution
- The September PAME meeting was preceded by an AMSP one day workshop



Since PAME II 2014:

- Based on the discussions in Whitehorse, co-leads turned around another version that was distributed in October, with a comment period till the end of November
- Co-leads worked on revising the document through December, and distributed in advance of this meeting the final draft for consideration the deadline for PAME submissions was extended until February 17

In response to the comments in Whitehorse and subsequently, co-leads have made a special effort to:

- Focus the document by taking out some redundant, less contextual information, emphasizing objectives and actions
- Making it more strategic by taking out detail, and making the actions more generalized

- Some unresolved issues, as indicated by square brackets, for example...
- How to characterize impact (emphasis on cumulative?), and the relative significance of humans vs large scale trends with respect to pressures

Next Steps

- The co-leads have been working to resolve these last few issues, especially as they relate to the strategic actions
- This meeting is the opportunity to finalize the text, so that the necessary formatting can occur
