Near Term Actions (2015-2017)

- Develop an approach for network design (e.g. representativity)
- Refine and map the MPA inventory
- Identify types of important marine areas
- Identifymeasures to address change in the Arctic
- Develop options for financing
- Identify benefits of MPAs and MPA Networks
