In response to periodic review of the guidance contained in the 2009 Arctic Offshore Oil and Gas Guidelines, recognizing the that EPPR has the mandate for the emergency topics covered in the 2009 AOOGG, and further recognizing the new Arctic Offshore Regulator Forum and their focus on operational issues, the PAME Resource Exploration and Development Expert Group (REDEG) determined that updating sections (4) Environmental Monitoring, (5.2) Compliance Monitoring, (6.1) Waste Management, (6.2) Use and Discharge of Chemicals, (6.3) Emissions to Air, Decommissioning and Site Clearance (8.0) and the sections on engagement with Indigenous Peoples was a useful objective.
