# **ARIAS Implementation Coordinating Group**

For information and guidance

### CONTEXT:

The ARIAS Strategy and Action Plan was approved at the May 2017 Ministerial and an Implementation Coordination Group (CG) co-led by CAFF and PAME was formed to facilitate implementation of ARIAS. The purpose of the ICG is to guide implementation of ARIAS and provide recommendations regarding potential implementation actions and progress on areas of interest to the CAFF and/or PAME Working Groups. Any joint projects will need to be approved by both the CAFF and PAME (for marine) and by CAFF (for terrestrial).

### **ORGANISATION:**

The CG is co-led by the US and Canada. However, the nominated Canadian (PAME) lead had to withdraw in November and the USA (CAFF) lead withdrew in December.
