PAME I-2020 (Feb 2020)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Plenary presentation and discussion ○ MPA breakouts ○ Connect with EA EG, REDEG, and SEG and ask for input on information sources re: expanding uses ○ Ask for names of any experts for reference group
April 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Complete first drafts of background papers¹ and circulate for peer/national review ○ 1st AMAP light review of AMAP-derived content ○ 2nd draft of storyboard ○ Workshop on 2nd factsheet, possibly in tandem with Plastics Symposium or AMAP WG, based on Jan discussion with the PPs
May 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Develop first draft of factsheets (for mid-August circulation)
June 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Reviews of background papers due
July 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Revise background papers based on reviews
August 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Circulate draft factsheets out to PAME for review ○ 2nd round of AMAP light review
PAME II-2020 (Sept 2020)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ PAME discussion of substantive comments
September - November 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Develop 2nd factsheet drafts and circulate by mid-November for any final comments
December 2020 - January 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Finalize and submit factsheets for approval at PAME I-2021
PAME I-2021 (Feb 2021)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Aim for PAME approval of factsheets for submission to SAOs for Ministerial consideration
March-April 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Final editing, formatting, and graphic design
