1st Draft Agenda with Timeline for 23-25 September Plenary

PAME II-2020 and its associated expert group pre-meetings will be held online from 15-25 September 2020. We will use GoToMeeting, hosted by PAME's account. Below are details on the aim and schedule of the meeting.

The aim of PAME II-2020 is to discuss progress on pending projects and take any necessary decisions to resolve any outstanding issues so that planned deliverables for the May 2021 Ministerial Meeting can be timely submitted. Specific objectives include:

- 1 Leads on respective activities to provide status updates on progress to date in accordance with the PAME I-2020 Records of Decisions and the PAME 2019-2021 Work Plan and propose timelines to finalize respective activities/projects for deliverables to the 2021 Ministerial Meeting.
- 2 Decide on updates/timelines for the next SAO meeting (28-30 October 2020) to include a list of planned deliverables for the May 2021 Ministerial Meeting.
- 3 Compile proposed activities and projects for possible inclusion into the PAME Work Plan 2021-2023 to include draft content, new proposed projects and indications of lead/co-leads. The AMSP 2015-2025 Implementation Plan can serve as a framework.
- 4 Decide on timelines/milestones of actions and activities needed up to the May 2021 Ministerial Meeting to include the final draft of the PAME Work Plan 2021-2023 and inputs to the SAO Report to Ministers as per guidance from the Arctic Council/Iceland's Chairmanship.

Documents requiring decisions from this meeting should be distributed 30 days in advance, or by <u>28 August 2020</u> in accordance with the Arctic Council Working Group Common Operating Guidelines.

Order of PAME II-2020 Plenary Meeting 23-25 Sep:

- Pre-meeting expert group co-chairs attend the PAME II-2020 meeting on behalf of their respective expert group and provide a brief overview of discussions (15 min) and submit their draft RoDs to the PAME Secretariat by end of end of day Tuesday 22 September.
- Heads of Delegations (HoD) requesting to speak should raise their hand to the camera. As a
 secondary alternative, HoDs can type their request in the GoToMeeting chat box. HoDs are
 also welcome to invite other participants from their delegations to speak on their behalf
 once they have been given the floor.
- We kindly request that only HoDs have their video on throughout the meeting. Other
 delegates invited to speak by the meeting Chair or a HoD may turn their video on for the
 period they are speaking and to respond to any follow up questions or comments. Speakers
 should then turn their video off. This is necessary to ensure the quality of the online meeting
 and avoid technical difficulties.
- Participants can also provide input and pose questions in writing via the GoToMeeting chat function. The PAME Secretariat will be monitoring the meeting screen and the chat box to keep an orderly and updated list of speakers and questions posed for the Chair.

- Meeting approval of RoDs on 25 September.
